**Library of Congress** – One of the most important libraries in the world, it includes the largest rare book collection in North America.

- **Arlington National Cemetery** – This is definitely the most hallowed burial ground of the Nation's fallen. With over 600 acres dedicated to the hundreds of thousands who sacrificed their lives for our country, it is hard not to feel the utmost admiration and respect for these brave men and women.
