



# Boston – Plymouth Group Tour

## 3 Day/ 2 Night Group Tour

Visit Plymouth Rock; get to know the Pilgrims at Plymouth Plantation. See where they first stepped ashore at Plymouth Rock. In Boston, follow in the historic steps of Paul Revere and others.



- Local Tour Guide in Plymouth MA, for a Guided tour of Plymouth including: Plymouth Rock: Sometimes called the Cornerstone of the Nation, Plymouth Rock is one of the most widely-known historical landmarks in the United States.
- Visit the Mayflower II, a full scale reproduction of the 17th century sailing vessel that made the famous voyage in 1620.
- Your admission to Plymouth Plantation includes the Wampanoag Home site, 1627 English Village, Crafts Center and Nye Barn.
- Boston Dinner included at Faneuil Hall
- Boston Tour guide for a Guided tour of the Freedom Trail and its many historical attractions including - Copps Hill Burying Ground , North Church, Beacon Hill, Boston Common, Old State House, Faneuil Hall and Quincy Market.
- Paul Revere House guided tour. A national historic landmark, it is downtown Boston's oldest building and one of the few remaining from an early era in the history of colonial America.
- Lunch voucher included at Quincy Market.
- USS Constitution Museum: located in the Charleston Navy Yard, and bringing to life the stories of the individuals, who authorized, built, served on and preserved USS Constitution.
- View Old Ironsides, the oldest commissioned warship afloat in the world. Her history is rich and colorful and 200 years strong.
- View Bunker Hill Memorial.
- Drive by Cambridge - Harvard University.
- Dinner included at America's oldest restaurant; Union Oyster House -the oldest restaurant in Boston and the oldest restaurant in continuous service in the U.S. - the doors have always been open to diners since 1826.
- In Newport, Rhode Island take a tour at The Breakers. The grandest of Newport's summer "cottages" and a symbol of the Vanderbilt family's social and financial preeminence in turn of the century America.
