- **Walking Guided Tour of the Freedom Trail** – See many historical attractions such as the Copp's Hill Burying Ground, North Church, Beacon Hill, Boston Common, Old State House, Faneuil Hall and Quincy Market.
- **Tour the Old Ironsides & visit the USS Constitution Museum** – Welcome aboard the nation's oldest commissioned warship afloat in the world. Her history is rich and colorful and 200 years strong -- from fighting Barbary pirates on the "shores of Tripoli" to winning famous victories during the War of 1812. This USS Constitution museum brings to life the stories of the individuals, who authorized, built, served on and preserved USS Constitution.
- **Paul Revere House** - Enjoy a guided visit of this national historic landmark. This house is Boston's oldest building and one of the few remaining from an early era in the history of colonial America.
- **Faneuil Hall Marketplace & Quincy Market** – Enjoy some leisure time in this Boston National Historical Park and well known stop on the Freedom Trail. Located near the waterfront and today's Government Center, Faneuil Hall has been a marketplace and a meeting hall since 1742. It was the site of several speeches by Samuel Adams, James Otis, and others encouraging independence from Great Britain.
- **Fenway Park Tour** - Visit the ballpark where the Babe pitched, The Kid hit, Yaz dazzled and Ortiz still thrills young fans today.
- **Historic Boston sightseeing cruise** – Discover the historic and contemporary milestones of Boston's inner and outer harbors during this fun, informative, fully narrated tour. From the hero tales of the Revolutionary War to the local legends of the sea, you'll be entertained and enthralled. Other highlights you'll see include the nation's oldest continuously manned lighthouse, the Harbor Islands National Park Area, Boston's working port and examples of extravagant waterfront living.



- **John F. Kennedy presidential Library & Museum** – Experience the life of President John F. Kennedy by touring the 25 multimedia exhibits.
