Before making your dash to the top, get a photo taken with the Rocky statue to the right of the steps. Explore one of the largest and most comprehensive art museums in the United States featuring collections from around the world, including more than 300,000 works spanning 2,000 years.
- **Eastern State Penitentiary: America’s most historic Prison** – Visit this former state prison that has become a museum and a US National Historic Landmark.
