Day One

- **The National Mall**, home to many of the magnificent **museums of the Smithsonian Institution**, is a great place to start your day. See the magnificent jewels, dinosaurs and mammals on display at the **National Museum of Natural History**, the airplanes and interactive flight simulators at the **National Air and Space Museum**, and the stories, arts and crafts at the **National Museum of the American Indian**.
- There's more to explore on the **National Mall** than just the **Smithsonian Institution**. Art lovers won't want to miss a visit to the **National Gallery of Art**, while the **National Archives** is a must for any American history buff.
- Meet your **tour guide** for an overview **tour of DC** including the **White House Visitor's Center**; see the **Capitol Hill**, the **U.S. Capitol Building**, **Library of Congress**, the **Supreme Court and Embassy Row**.
- Check into your **Washington DC hotel**.
- Enjoy **Dinner** before you meet your **Tour Guide** to depart for a **tour of the DC Monuments** at moonlight, including **Jefferson Memorial, Lincoln Memorial, Reflecting Pool, Vietnam Memorial, WW II Memorial, Korean Memorial** and more.
- Return to your **Washington DC Hotel** for the evening.

Day Two

- After **breakfast**, start your morning at one of **Washington DC's prized attractions**, the **Washington National Cathedral**, and then visit the **Bureau of Printing and Engraving** and see what One Million Dollars looks like!
- After lunch, go undercover at the **International Spy Museum**, where you can crack codes, take on covers and even let your group take on its own covert operation. Or, stop by the **National Portrait Gallery** and **Smithsonian American Art Museum**, the newest addition to the Smithsonian system.
- Another **Washington DC attraction** that you might want to include is **Madame Tussauds** - an interactive, full sensory experience where you can touch, see and hear historical events and celebrities in a way unlike any other **DC attraction**. Ride to the top of the **Washington Monument** or the **Old Post Office Pavilion** for a **panoramic view** of the city.
- Animal lovers may also wish to pay a visit to the **National Zoo**, home to **giant pandas**, cheetahs, tigers and other exotic species. **Dinner** included then departs for an evening of entertainment. Delight to the performance of **Sheer Madness** or perhaps enjoy your dinner and entertainment at **Medieval Times Dinner Tournament**.
- Return to your **Washington DC hotel** for the night.

Day Three

- After **Breakfast**, tour **Arlington Cemetery**, America's shrine to valor and sacrifice, the final resting place of **President John F. Kennedy** and thousands of soldiers from every major US war. See the **Tomb of the Unknown Soldier**.
- Then head to **Georgetown** for lunch on your own and sightseeing in this charming



historic setting.

- This afternoon visit **Mount Vernon**, the home of **George and Martha Washington**. Discover the real George Washington with a Hollywood-produced action adventure movie, interactive exhibits, more than 1000 artifacts, original films and life size models of George Washington.
- Dinner tonight is **Pizza buffet and a Disco Dance Party** for your **group**.
- Return to your **Washington DC hotel** at 11pm

Day Four

- **Breakfast**, tour the **United States Memorial Holocaust Museum** and see the permanent exhibit: **The Holocaust**.
- Later, depart for home.
